### 1. President (Steve):

#### 2. First Vice President (Diana):

- External affairs update:
  - The Commonwealth Transportation Board will host meetings to allow public feedback on several proposed projects.
  - The Fairfax County Park Authority has a plan to permanently save Lake Accotink.
  - Fairfax County has changed the requirements for glass recycling.
  - One University's rezoning application was approved.
- Discussed "Haunted Trail" in the CCV park proposed by TJ McCurdy:
  - ❖ Will ask TJ to contact the county to see whether this would be allowed.
  - We could not charge a fee, but could ask for donations to the scholarship fund.
  - ❖ If this idea is feasible, could continue discussion at January meeting.
