# MASON: WHO ARE WE?

- Virginia's largest public research university, with over 38,000 students
  - One of 131 U.S. universities to receive highest research designation from Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education
- Over 7,000 faculty and staff
- A physical campus presence throughout the region (Arlington, Fairfax, Prince William) and Korea
- 200,000+ alumni - - 60% who have stayed in the DC Region
- More than half of Mason's undergraduates are students of color, and Mason exceeds national graduation rates regardless of race, ethnicity or wealth status
- Best value in higher education – producing graduates who lead all Virginia schools with the highest annual salaries

# COVID-19 RESPONSE AT MASON

- More than 91% of Mason students, faculty, and staff are vaccinated
- Initiated the largest-scale surveillance testing protocol of any Virginia university - up to 13,000 members of the Mason community/week. Other Virginia universities are testing 500 to 3,000 individuals/week.
- Notifying every student, faculty, and staff member who may have been exposed to someone testing positive for COVID.
- Since August 23, we are tracking 83 positive cases among our nearly 50,000 students, faculty, and staff.
- Daily online Mason COVID health check required for all Mason community and visitors to campus.
- Masks are required in all indoor settings unless actively eating or drinking.
